Please complete and return the forms by August 1, 2017. A friendly reminder that the September tuition payment, including your Hartley Nature Center membership, is due on or by your first day of school. You will receive your September 2017 invoice in August. The first day of school is also the last day to take advantage of the discount for paying the full year's tuition in one payment.

Feel free to have your doctor's office fax or mail the health forms straight to Hartley at 218-724-4891; we need to have your child's immunization record BEFORE they may attend preschool. The health care summary must be submitted to Hartley no later than October 4th and must be completed by your child's health care provider. If you need medication administration forms or an Individualized Child Care Plan, please download the forms from the preschool website (www.hartleynature.org) or contact Kaitlin or Maria for a copy of the forms.

We look forward to seeing you at Parent Orientation on August 29th (full day orientation) at 5:30 pm or August 30th (half day orientation) at 5:30 pm. All new and returning parents are encouraged to attend parent orientation; please leave children older than infants at home. We look forward to meeting you and your child at Preschool Meet and Greet on August 31st at your class's assigned time. Please look below to find your class's time for Meet and Greet with your teachers and classmates on August 31st. Older and younger siblings are welcome at Meet and Greet.

New Student Enrollment Form Checklist

The following forms are included in the Enrollment Packet and must be submitted **prior to your child's first day of preschool:**

- Enrollment Information Form which includes the Preschool Service Contract and Parent Handbook Agreement
- Hartley Nature Center family membership (at least \$50 level)
- Emergency Information Form
- Immunization History
- Sunscreen and Bug Spray Form (full day only)
- Payment Option Form

Submit Within 30 Days of Enrollment

- Health Care Summary

Submit If Applicable—Please download these forms from the preschool website or contact a preschool staff member for a copy of these forms. Please arrange a meeting to discuss your child's care with his/her teachers:

- Individualized Child Care Plan for health or special needs
- Medication Administration Form (prescription and/or over-the-counter)

****If you have more than one child attending HNP please fill out separate forms for each child.**

Parent/guardian will provide the following for every HALF DAY preschool session:

- Hearty, healthy snack
- Small backpack Water bottle
- Seasonally appropriate outdoor clothing and boots

Can be left at preschool each day:

- Indoor shoes
- 1-2 complete changes of clothes

Parent/guardian will provide the following for every FULL DAY preschool session:

- Hearty, healthy lunch
- Healthy morning AND afternoon snacks
- Small backpack Water bottle
- Seasonally appropriate outdoor clothing and boots

Can be left at preschool each day:

- Blanket and pillow for rest time
- Security toy for rest time
- Indoor shoes
- 1-2 complete changes of clothes
