The first day of school is also the last day to take advantage of the discount for paying the full year's tuition in one payment.

If you need to update an immunization record, health care summary, Individualized Child Care Plan for allergies or special needs, or medication administration form, please download the forms from the preschool website (www.hartleynature.org) or contact preschool staff for a copy of the forms.

We look forward to seeing you at Parent Orientation on August 28th (full day orientation) at 5:00 pm or August 29th (half day orientation) at 5:00 pm. All returning parents are encouraged to attend parent orientation; we're planning some exciting changes to orientation for this year! Please leave children older than infants at home. Returning Student Enrollment Form Checklist

The following forms must be updated annually, are included in the Enrollment Packet, and must be submitted **PRIOR to your child's first day of preschool:**

- Enrollment Information Form which includes the Preschool Service Contract and Parent Handbook Agreement
- Hartley Nature Center family membership renewal (at least \$50 level)
- Emergency Information Sheet (including dentist and doctor information)
- Payment Option Form

Submit if applicable PRIOR to your child's first day of preschool: —Please download these forms from the preschool website or contact preschool staff for a copy of these forms and arrange a meeting to discuss your child's care with his/her teachers:

- Individualized Child Care Plan for allergies or other health care needs
- Medication Administration Form (prescription and/or over-the-counter)
- IEP for special needs

Update and submit only if there are changes:

- Immunization History
(remember to sign the correct box on Page 2)
- Health Care Summary

****If you have more than one child attending HNP please fill out separate forms for each child.**

Bring the following every HALF DAY preschool session:

- Hearty, healthy snack
- Small backpack Water bottle
- Seasonally appropriate outdoor clothing and boots

Can be left at preschool:

- Indoor shoes
- 1-2 complete changes of clothes

Bring the following every FULL DAY preschool session:

- Hearty, healthy lunch
- Healthy morning AND afternoon snacks
- Small backpack Water bottle
- Seasonally appropriate outdoor clothing and boots

Can be left at preschool:

- Small blanket and pillow for rest time inside a reusable shopping bag or similar sized bag
- Small comfort item for rest time
- Indoor shoes
- 1-2 complete changes of clothes

Early Learning Scholarships

State of MN Early Learning Scholarships are for 3 and 4 year old children whose families meet financial requirements. HNP is a four star Parent Aware rated program, so up to \$7,500 per scholarship will be awarded. Children who turn 5 before September 1 are not eligible for Early Learning Scholarships.
